As part of The Ohio State University's commitment to promoting a safe and healthy campus environment, members of the university community have the right to be free from all forms of hazing, which impede the realization of the university's vision of being a 21st-century public, land grant, research, urban, and community-engaged institution. The university does not tolerate hazing in any form and all members of the university community must conduct themselves in a manner that supports an environment free from hazing.

Collin's Law requires universities to provide updated reports before the first day of January and August each year. Delta Kappa Epsilon also is prohibited from using the name, logos and other trademarks of The Ohio State University and any prior permissions granted to the organization by the university's Office of Trademark and Licensing are revoked. This includes, but is not limited to, the usage of Brutus and the university's name on the Delta Kappa Epsilon social media pages. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in referral to the university's Office of Trademark and Licensing for review and possible enforcement action.
		Continued operation of Delta Kappa Epsilon will prevent any consideration of a return to the community as a registered student organization until operations cease.
